Webinar On “Importance of Professional Training & Readiness for Successful Industrial Placement”

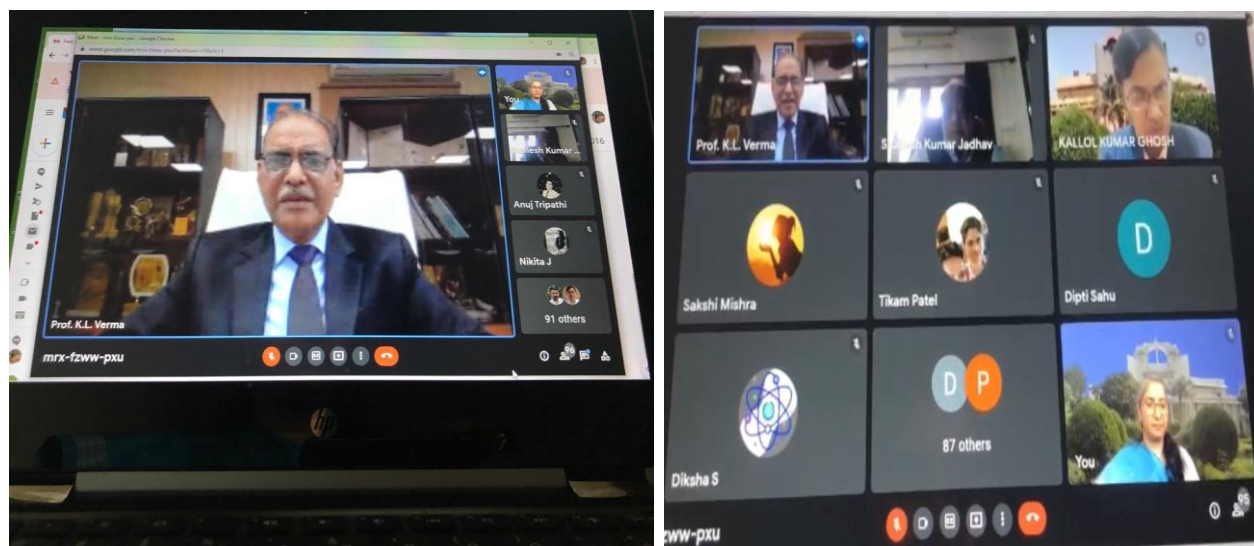

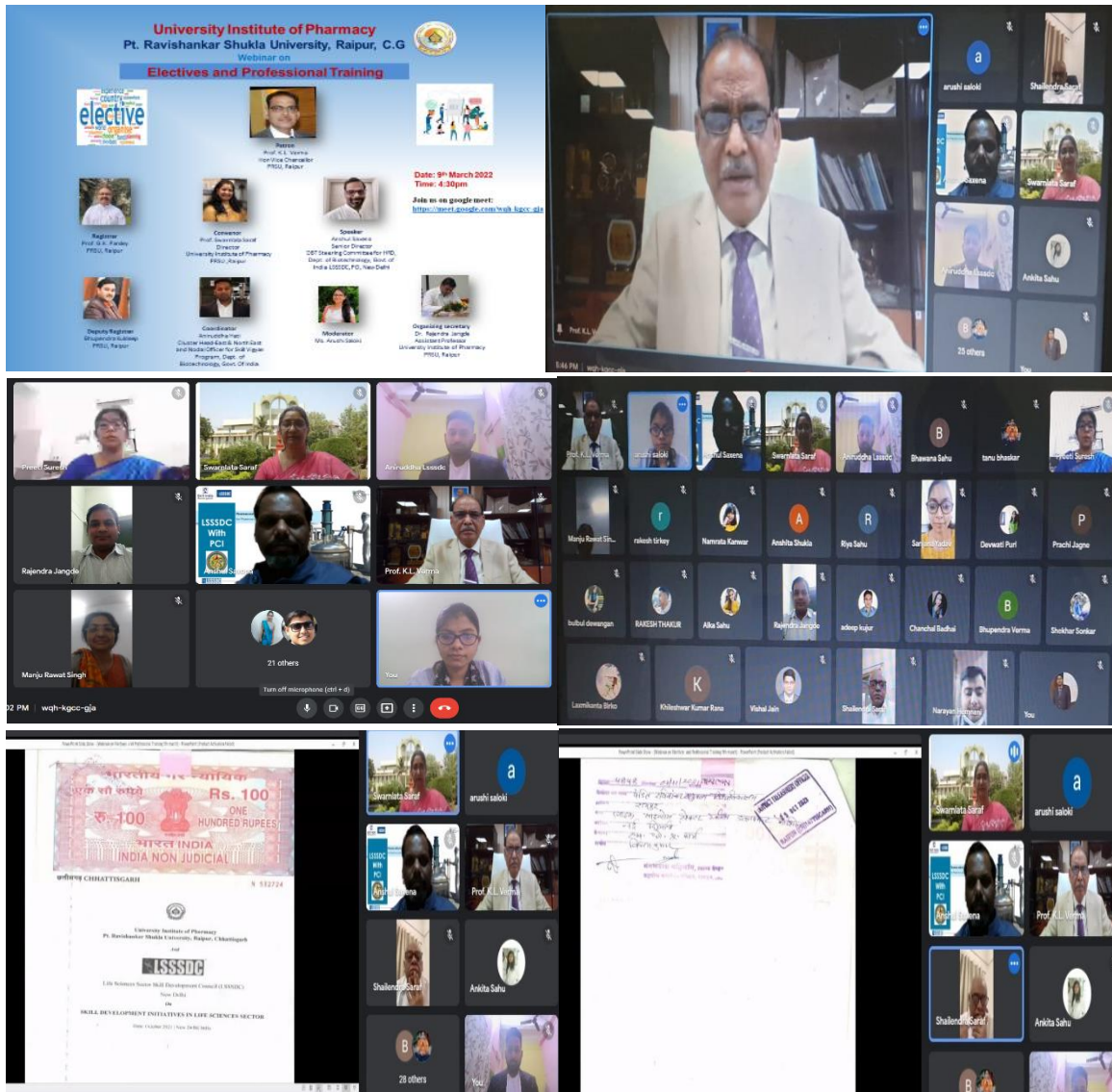

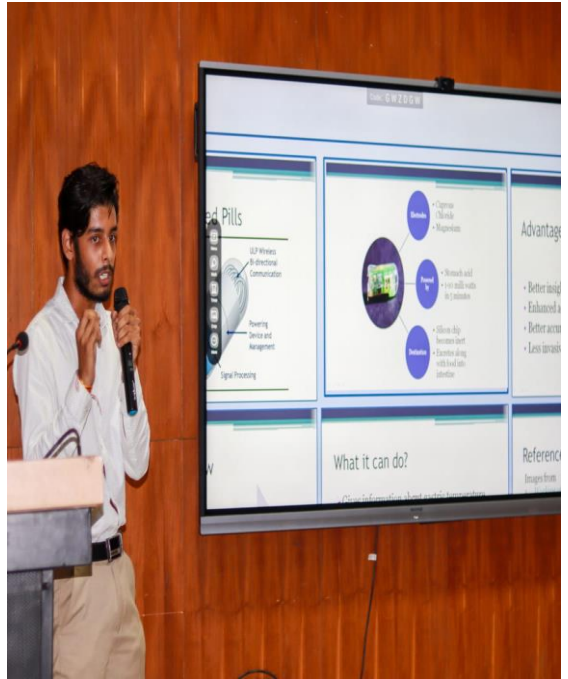
