विश्वविद्यालय कार्यपरिषद् की बैठक दिनांक 23.10.2024 के निर्णय क्रमांक 1 एवं छत्तीसगढ़ शासन, उच्च शिक्षा विभाग, मंत्रालय, महानदी भवन, नवा रायपुर अटल नगर, रायपुर से प्राप्त पत्र क्रमांक एफ 3-44/2024/38-2 दिनांक 20.01.2024 के अनुक्रम में अध्यादेश क्रमांक 60 "Master of Laws (LL.M.)" में संशोधन, माननीय कुलाधिपति महोदय द्वारा अनुमोदित को अंगीकृत किए जाने का निर्णय लिया गया, जो निम्नांकित है -

ORDINANCE NO 60- Master of Laws (LL.M.) Examination	01 The Course for the Degree of Master of Laws under this Ordinance shall extend over a period of two academic years comprising four semesters in all, for each semester there shall be held an examination in the papers prescribed for the said semester concerned. These semesters shall be called as : LL.M. Part-I - First Semester LL.M. Part-I - Second Semester LL.M. Part-II - First Semester LL.M. Part-II - Second Semester	1. <i>The Master Degree in 'Master of Law' of 2 years (4 Semester) duration herewith after shall be designated in short LLM.</i>
	02 LL.M. First Semester shall be made in the month of July every year and the Second Semester examination shall be held in the month of January of the following year. Examinations for all the Semesters shall be held twice a year, namely, January/February and July/August.	2. <i>Duration of the program The program of study for LLM shall extend over a period of four semesters (two academic years). The curricula and syllabi for the program shall be prescribed from time to time by University.</i> <i>These Semesters shall be called as-</i> <i>LLM- First Semester</i> <i>LLM- Second Semester</i> <i>LLM- Third Semester</i> <i>LLM- Fourth Semester</i>

	03	<p>a) A Candidate who after having passed the three years course for the degree of Bachelor of Laws of the University or of any other statutory University recognised as equivalent thereto, with atleast 55% of marks (incase of ST/SC/OBC candidate 50% of the marks LL.B. or equivalent Examination) has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one Semester session in the University Department of Law or any college affiliated to the University shall be eligible to appear at the LL.M. Part-I, First Semester Examination.</p> <p>b) A candidate who after having passed LL.M. Part-I, 1st Semester Examination of the University has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one semester session in the University Department of Law, or in an affiliated College shall be eligible to present himself/herself at the LL.M. part-I, Second Semester Examination.</p> <p>c. A candidate who, after having passed LL.M. Part-I, Second Semester Examination of this University has prosecuted a regular course of prescribed study for one Semester session in the University Department of Law or a College affiliated to the University shall be eligible to appear at LL.M. Part-II, First Semester Examination.</p> <p>d)A candidate who after having passed the LL.M. Part-II, First Semester Examination of this University has prosecuted a regular course of study for one Semester session in this University Department of Law or a College affiliated to the University shall be eligible to appear at the LL.M. Part-II, Second Semester Examination.</p>	<p>3. <i>Minimum qualification for admission</i> <i>The minimum qualification for admission to first semester of LLM course an applicant who has graduated in Law (LLB three year or LLB five year integrated course) with at least 55% (50% marks in case SC, ST reserved candidate) marks in aggregate from a University established by an Act of Parliament or by a State legislature or an equivalent national institution recognized as a Deemed to be University or foreign University recognized as equivalent to the status of an Indian University by an authority competent to declare equivalence, may apply for a two years' post graduate degree program in law leading to conferment of LLM.</i></p>

	04	<p>a) No candidate shall be permitted to appear for any of the LL.M. Semester Examination unless he has attended atleast 75% of the total number of Lectures and Seminars held during the Semester session.</p> <p>b). admission to the examination shall submit through the Principal or Head of the Department as the case may be, application on prescribed form, together with necessary fees and following certificates from the Principal / Head of the Department, viz certificates of :</p> <p>i. Good Conduct</p> <p>ii. Fitness to present , himself/herself at the examination and,</p> <p>iii. Part-II, Second Semester Examination, the marks obtained by them in the written examination as well as the viva-voce shall be taken into account.</p> <p>A Successful candidate shall be assigned division on the basis of</p>	<p><i>4. Prohibition to register for two regular courses of study</i> <i>No student shall be allowed to simultaneously register for a LLM program with any other graduate or postgraduate or certificate course run by the same or any other University or an Institute for academic or professional learning excepting in the integrated degree program of the same institution.</i></p> <p><i>Provided that any short period part time certificate course on language, computer science or computer application of an Institute or any course run by a Centre for Distance Learning of a University however, shall be excepted.</i></p>

		<p>the marks obtained by him/her in all the four semester examinations taken together. Those who secure 60% marks or more shall be placed in the FIRST DIVISION. All other successful candidates shall be placed in the SECOND DIVISION.</p> <p>A candidate who has been declared unsuccessful at a semester examination may at his/her option re-appear at it subsequently as ex-student without being required to attend regular course of study again for the same semester subject to the condition that such a candidate shall abide by and shall be governed by provision of this and other ordinances as applicable.</p>	
	05	The Executive Council shall publish the results of the examination as soon as possible for it.	<p><i>5. Medium of instruction and examinations</i> Medium of instruction and examination shall be in English and or Hindi only.</p>
	06	No Provision in Present	<p><i>6. Working days in each semester</i> Each semester shall consist of not less than 90 working days. The odd semesters shall be conducted from the month of June/July to November/December and the even semesters shall be conducted from the month of December/January to May/June in every calendar year.</p>
	07	No Provision in Present	<p><i>7. Attendance and progress</i> A candidate is required to put in at least 75% attendance in individual subjects considering theory Lectures, Practical works and Seminars, etc. The Vice Chancellor may condone 15% of attendance on the recommendation of Head of School of Studies/ Principal in genuine cases. The candidate shall complete the prescribed course satisfactorily to be eligible to appear for the respective examinations.</p>

08	No Provision in Present	<p><i>8. Examinations/Assessments</i></p> <p><i>8.1. End semester examinations</i></p> <p><i>The End Semester Examinations for each courses through semesters I to IV shall be conducted by the university.</i></p> <p><i>8.2. Internal assessment Exams</i></p> <p><i>One Internal assessment Exams of Marks Twenty only, shall be conducted for each subjects as per the schedule fixed by the university/institute.</i></p>
09	No Provision in Present	<p>9. Promotion and award of grades</p> <p><i>(i) A student shall be declared PASS and he/she secures at least 50% aggregate marks in that particular semester and 40% individual subjects including internal assessment. Provided that for the purpose of declaration of the result of candidates appearing in LL.M. forth Semester Examination, the marks obtained by them in the written examination as well as the viva-voce shall be taken into account.</i></p> <p><i>(ii) A student who has completed their semester examination should attend the next semester classes immediately. Also take admission in the next semester within ten days, after declaration of semester results (Pass / ATKT /ATNS student).</i></p> <p><i>(iii) A candidate who fails to secure minimum pass mark (40%) in any subject may improve the same at the next semester examination (ATKT).</i></p> <p><i>(iv) There will be no supplementary examination</i></p>



			<p>(v) Standard of passing:</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. Minimum 40% marks in individual paper. b. There shall be 50% marks in aggregate in each semester examination. c. A candidate who has secured the minimum passing marks in all the papers but has not obtained an aggregate of 50% marks shall be given the option to select any two theory papers of the concerned semester to make up for the shortfall in the 50% aggregate for each semester. For the improvement of marks, the candidate shall not appear in any practical subjects.
	10	No Provision in Present	<p>10. Carry forward of marks <i>In case a student fails to secure the minimum aggregate 50% in any subjects, then he/she shall reappear for the end semester examination of that course. However his/her marks of the Internal Assessment shall be carried over and he/she shall be entitled for grade obtained by him/her on passing.</i></p>
	11	No Provision in Present	<p>11. Allowed to Keep Terms (ATKT): <i>No student shall be admitted to any examination unless he/she fulfills</i></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a. A student shall be eligible to carry forward all the subjects of I, II and III semester till the IV semester examination. b. For the promotion to the higher semester the sequence shall be adhered to. c. <i>No Candidate will be awarded degree of L.L.M. unless he/she passed all the four semester examination. If any previous semester, paper remains as backlog to be cleared by him/her the result</i>

			<i>will be withheld till he/she passed the backlog.</i>
	12	No Provision in Present	<p>12. Prohibition against lateral entry and exit There shall be no lateral entry on the plea of post-graduation in any subject or exit by way of awarding a degree. Admission Process for the Students from Universities other than Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur or Colleges- It is being proposed that if a student who after having passed LLM first semester and second semester from another university or College and wants to take admission in LLM third semester of Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University then that student will be eligible for admission only if the syllabus of each semesters of other university or College is same to same/ identical as of Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur.</p>
	13	No Provision in Present	<p>13. Award of degree A successful candidate shall be awarded division on the basis of marks obtained by him/her in all four semester examination taken together. Those who secure 60% or more shall be in 1st division. All other successful candidates' having marks less than 60% shall be placed in 2nd division.</p>
	14	No Provision in Present	<p>14. Duration for completion of the program of study <i>The duration for the completion of the program shall be fixed as double the actual duration (i.e. within 4 years from the date of admission) of the program and the students have to pass within the said period, otherwise their admission will stand cancelled.</i></p>
	15	No Provision in Present	<p><i>15. Not Eligible for LLM two Years 6course- Mark sheets are not generated from the</i></p>

			<i>University for the Students who admitted in first semester but did not submitted the form or appeared in semester exams. Those students will not be eligible for readmission in LLM two Years Course and also not come into the category of Ex-Students.</i>
	16	No Provision in Present	16. Revaluation / Retotaling of answer papers <i>There is no provision for revaluation of the answer papers in any examination. However, the candidates can apply for retotaling by paying prescribed fee.</i>
	17	No Provision in Present	17. The provisions of Ordinances 5 and 6 shall be applicable only to the extent that they are not inconsistent with the provision of this Ordinance.
