In case of an examinee for Master of Computer Applications, who is not a regular student of the department/college, the sessional marks obtained during the period in which the candidate pursued the course for the examination in the department/college shall be taken into account for the purpose of determining their result at the examination.
<del></del>	10. The minimum passing marks which an examinee shall have to obtain in each subject shall be (i) 40% in each theory paper (ii) 60% in each sessional and (iii) 50% in each practical/project examination.
	11. A candidate shall be eligible to be promoted and appear in the succeeding semester examination only if he/she fails in not more than two (theory/practical/ project/seminar) papers in any one semester examination.
	12. A candidate failing in not more than two (theory/practical/project/seminar) papers of any semester shall be eligible to take examination of the paper in which he has failed along with the current semester examination.
	13. If a candidate fails in more than two (theory/practical/project/seminar) papers in any one semester examination he/she will be year back and he/she will be appearing in the failing papers only.
New Point	14. A candidate will be permitted to appear in the examination of the course for a maximum period of 5 years including the years of admission. If he / she fails to clear the course within the period of 5 years, he /she will be dropped out of the course.
New Point	15. A candidate, who fails to obtain minimum marks in sessional of any subject, will be treated as failed and will have to repeat the whole semester. He/she will have to attend the classes of all the subjects of the respective semester to earn requisite sessional marks and again appear in all theory and
