विश्वविद्यालय कार्यपरिषद् की बैठक दिनांक 27.05.2024 के निर्णय क्रमांक 1 एवं छत्तीसगढ़ शासन, उच्च शिक्षा विभाग, मंत्रालय, महानदी भवन, नवा रायपुर अटल नगर, रायपुर से प्राप्त पत्र क्रमांक एफ 3–31/2024/38–2 दिनांक 09.09.2024 के अनुक्रम में अध्यादेश क्रमांक 170 "M.A. Sindhi एवं M.Sc. Renewable Energy Technology (RET)" एवं अन्य संशोधन माननीय कुलाधिपति महोदय द्वारा अनुमोदित को अंगीकृत किए जाने का निर्णय लिया गया, जो निम्नांकित है –

pursue regularly the prescribed courses in each of the four semesters successively. The Master's Degree shall be awarded to those candidates who have obtained at least 36% marks in cumulative aggregate in each of four semesters in theory and practical courses separately and a minimum of 20% qualifying marks in each theory course. The successful candidate shall be placed in divisions on the following basis.

An aggregate of 60% or above-l Division An aggregate of 48% or above - Il Division


An aggregate of 36% or above – III Division

Every candidate thus admitted shall pursue regularly the prescribed courses in each of the four semesters successively. The Master's Degree shall be awarded to those candidates who have obtained a minimum SGPA of 4 in each of the four semesters and at least a grade letter "P" in each course of four semesters in theory and practical separately (taking together courses continuous internal assessment and end semester evaluation). The successful candidate shall be placed in divisions on the following basis.

Description

- (i) Letter grades O, A+, A, B+, B, C, and P awarded to a student in a course means that the student has passed that course.
- (ii) The grade **F** and **Ab** denote **FAIL**; a student fails in the course due to poor performance or non-appearance/incomplete appearance in the examination held for the course. A student may appear in subsequent examination(s), as per the provisions of the Ordinances in all such courses, until a passing grade is obtained, which shall be subject to maximum time limit set out for completion of the programme.
- (iii) Semester Grade Point Average $(SGPA) = \Sigma(Ci \times Gi) / \Sigma Ci$ where, Ci is the number of credits of the ith course and Gi is the grade point scored by the student in the ith course.
- (iv) Cumulative Grade Point Average $(CGPA) = \Sigma(C_i \times S_i) / \Sigma C_i$ where, S_i is the SGPA of the ith semester and C_i is the total number of credits in that semester.
- A student falling to appear or securing less than 36% aggregate or obtained less than 20% marks in any of the theory course of I, II & III semester examinations shall be allowed to pursue the courses for the next following semester. Such students shall have failed or failed in aggregate (with ATKT) or ATKT status in I, II III or IV semesters and their scheme of examination shall be as follows:
 - (i) A student falling to qualify the examinations of any semester shall be permitted to appear in the ATKT/ reexamination along with the following semester examination.
 - (ii) A student who has failed in ATKT/ reexamination shall reappear as ex-student.
 - (iii) A student who has been admitted to any semester but fails to fill up examination form of that semester examination or debarred to take examination due to short attendance or any other reasons, then he/she shall have

- (i) A student failing to appear or securing at least 4.0 SGPA or at least a grade letter "P" in each course shall be allowed to pursue the courses in the next following semester.
 - However, only those students shall be allowed to pursue the third semester who have earned at least 50% credits of the total credits of first and second semester.
- (ii) Examinations of back papers of odd semesters shall be conducted along with odd semesters end examinations, similarly examinations of back papers of even semesters shall be conducted along with even semesters end examinations.
- (iii) The total duration for completing the programme shall not exceed 4 years.
