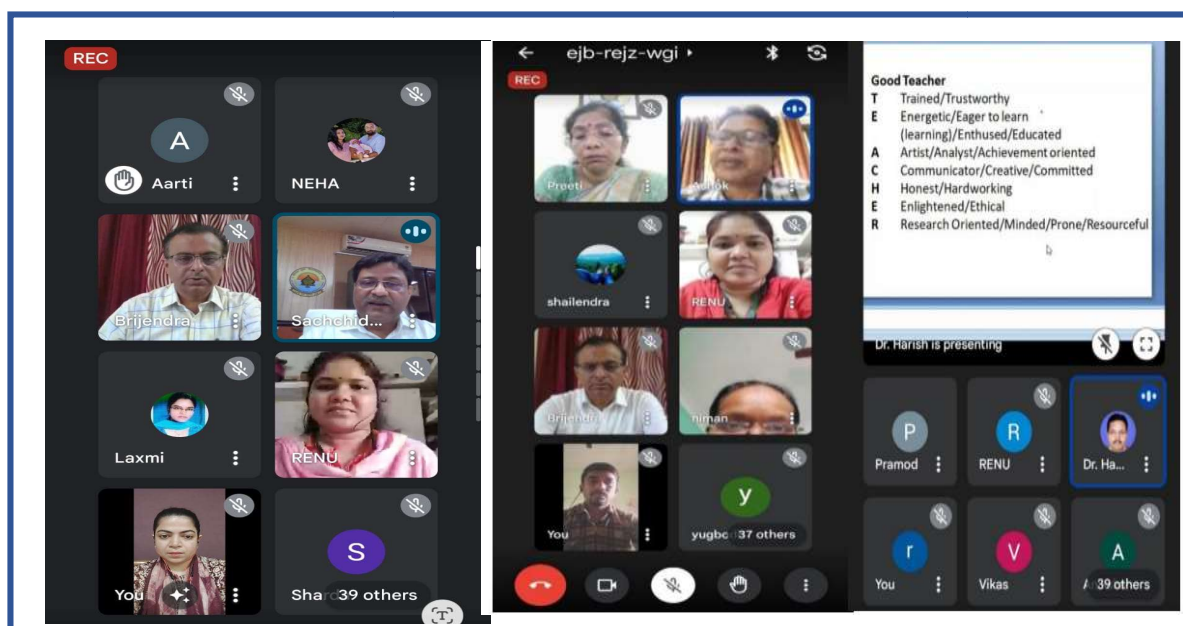

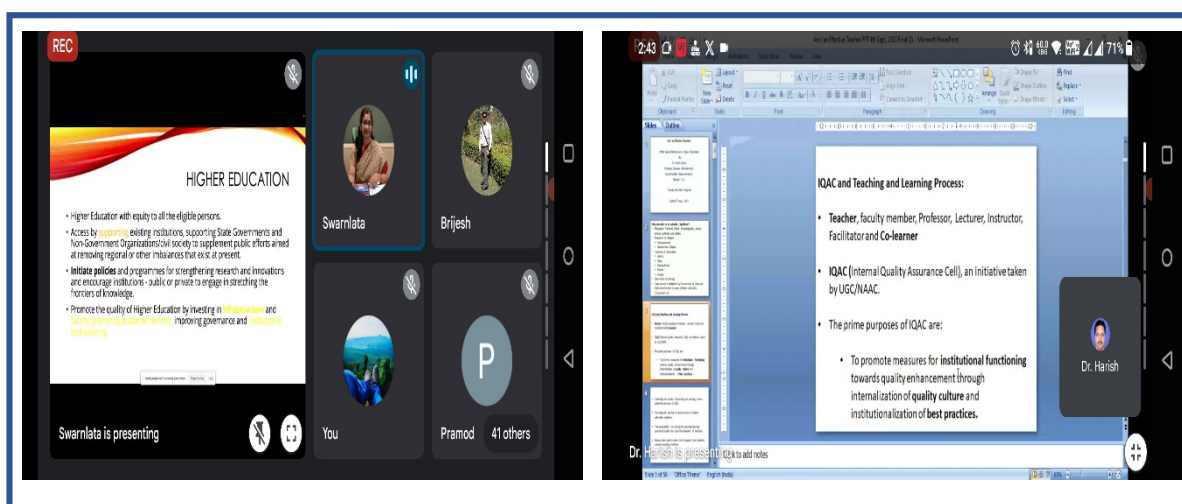
**Day 1<sup>st</sup> 04/09/2023: Second Session to Fourth Session 12:15 PM to 05:30 PM**

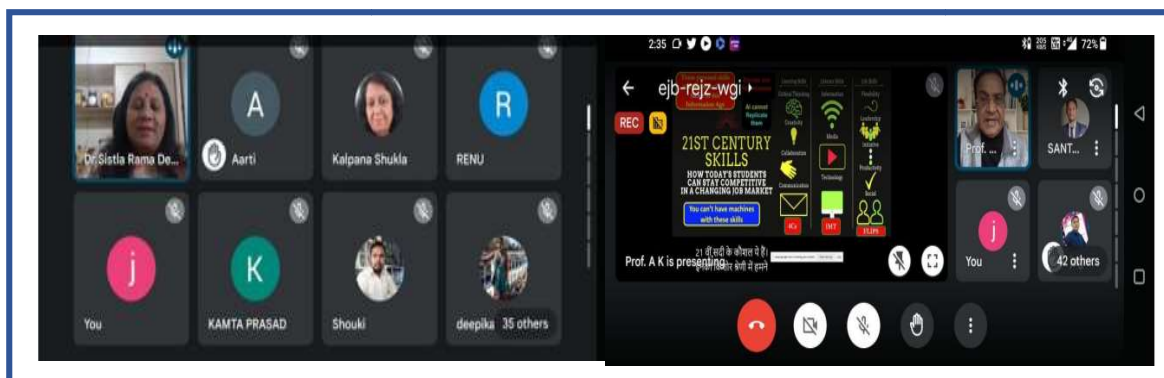

**Day 2<sup>nd</sup> 05/09/2023: First Session to Fourth Session 10:30 PM to 05:30 PM**

On the 2nd day of this program, Miss. Deepti Pardhi, Assistant Professor of History, was the chairperson, and Miss. Jyoti Kaushal, Assistant Professor of Physics, was the rapporteur. 40 members participated in this session.

During 1st and 2nd sessions, Dr. S. Rama Devi Pani, Editor, University News, New Delhi, was the Resource Person. Mam delivered her lecture on "History of one's own University/College/Institute". Mam started her lecture by talking about Ancient Indian Higher Education and the Establishment of various Universities in India.

She told us about three dimensions of universities and also informed us about the Association of Indian Universities and its work, the Ministry of Education, Governing bodies, the Need for Research, etc. Mam ended her talk by talking about the code of conduct and Professional Ethics. Participants asked some questions regarding the topic. The session was very interactive and informative.

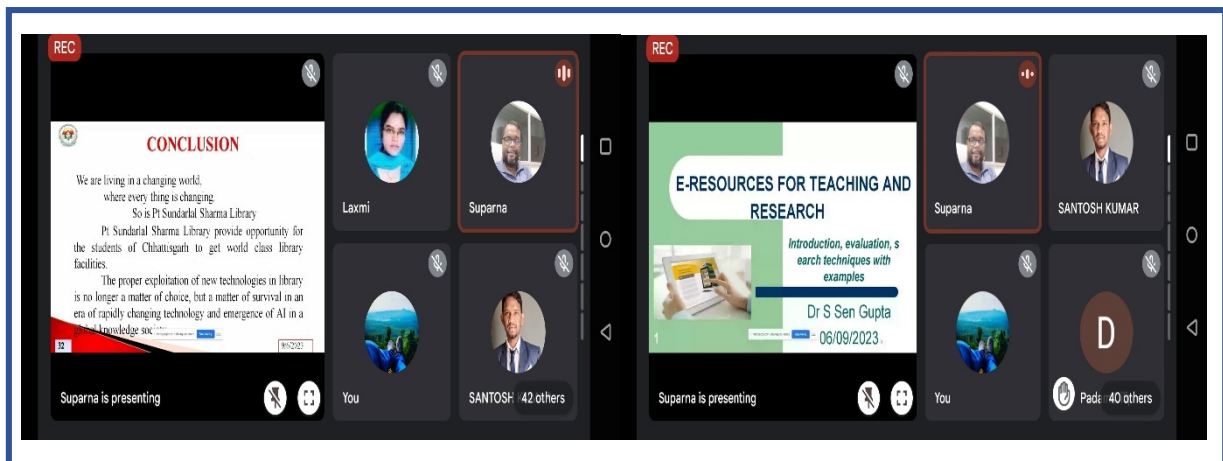

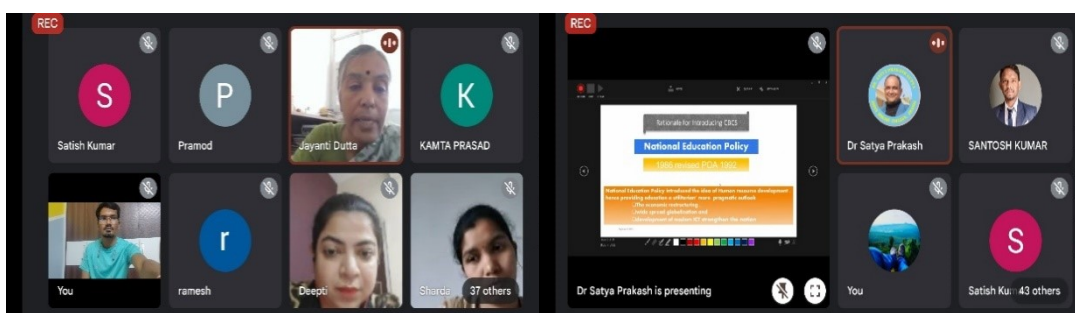


## Module 02: Choice-Based Credit System & Curriculum

Day 4<sup>th</sup> 08/09/2023: First Session to Fourth Session 10:30 PM to 05:30 PM

On the 4th day of this program, Mr. Tameshwar Markandey, Assistant Professor of Zoology, was the chairperson, and Mr. Pramod Bharti, Assistant Professor of Commerce, was the rapporteur. 40 members participated in this session.

In the 1st and 2nd sessions, Dr. Jayanti Dutta Roy, Deputy Director of UGC-HRDC at Punjab University, Chandigarh, was the speaker. She discussed "Framing Curriculum Objectives, Organization of Contents, and Taxonomies of Instructional Objectives." Dr. Roy emphasized student-centered teaching, creative thinking, and the three dimensions of taxonomies: cognitive, affective, and psychomotor. She provided examples related to these taxonomies, making the session highly interactive and informative.

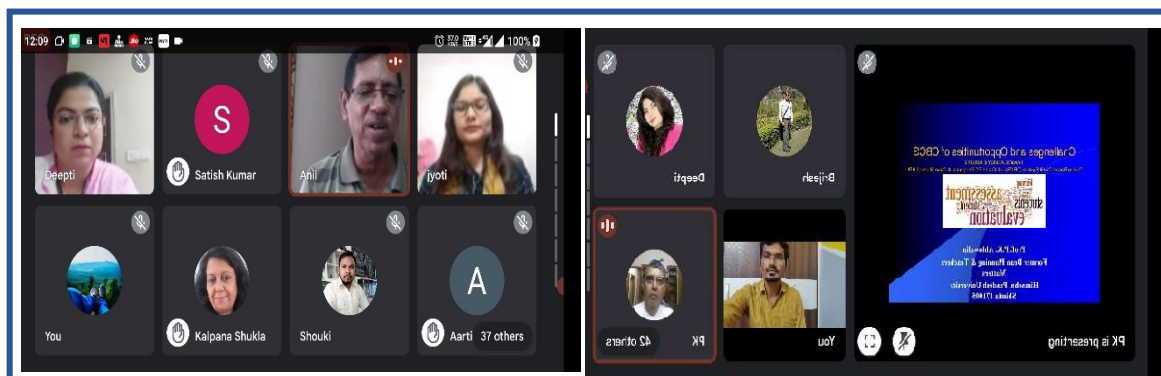

Gupta from the Department of Botany at Bipin Bihari College, Jhansi, talked about "Opportunities and Challenges of CBCS Compared to Annual and Semester-Based Systems, and CBCS Case Studies." He explained the meaning, evolution, opportunities, and challenges of CBCS under NEP. Prof. Gupta also discussed the multi-disciplinary entry and exit system and shared case studies of CBCS implementation in various universities. The session was rich in knowledge and left a strong impression.

**Day 5<sup>th</sup> 11/09/2023: First Session to Fourth Session 10:30 PM to 05:30 PM**

On the 5<sup>th</sup> day of this program, Mr. Kausalesh Kumar Dhruw, Assistant Professor of Geography was the chairperson, and Mrs. Sangeeta Bhagat, Assistant Professor of Commerce, was the rapporteur. 40 members participated in this session.

In the first session, Prof. Anil Kumar, a retired professor from NITTTR, Bhopal, discussed the 'Idea of curriculum and different perspectives on the curriculum.' He began by addressing various aspects of the curriculum, engaging with participants and answering their questions.

During the second session, he delved into topics such as curriculum implementation, reflection, and the distinction between curriculum and syllabus. He concluded by assigning participants a task related to the curriculum and syllabus in various subjects.



In the third session, Prof. P.K. Ahluwalia, a retired professor from Himachal Pradesh University, addressed the 'Challenges and Opportunities of CBCS towards academic reforms.' He highlighted the current shortcomings in the education system and introduced the concept of CBCS along with its features.

In the fourth session, he provided an in-depth exploration of CBCS, engaging participants and addressing their questions. The sessions were rich in detail and engagement.

Additionally, there was a session on the NAAC Accreditation process, covering topics like preparing IIQA and SSR, the 7 criteria of NAAC Accreditation, quantitative metrics, key indicators, and benchmark documents. 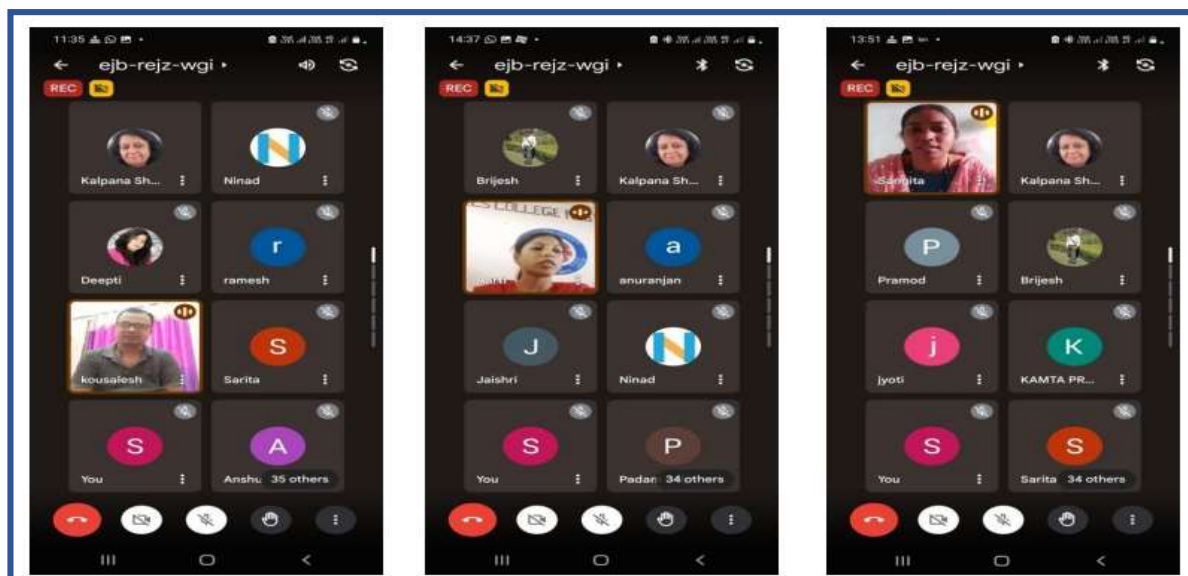
Overall, all four sessions were informative, interactive, and motivating, and participants were actively engaged.

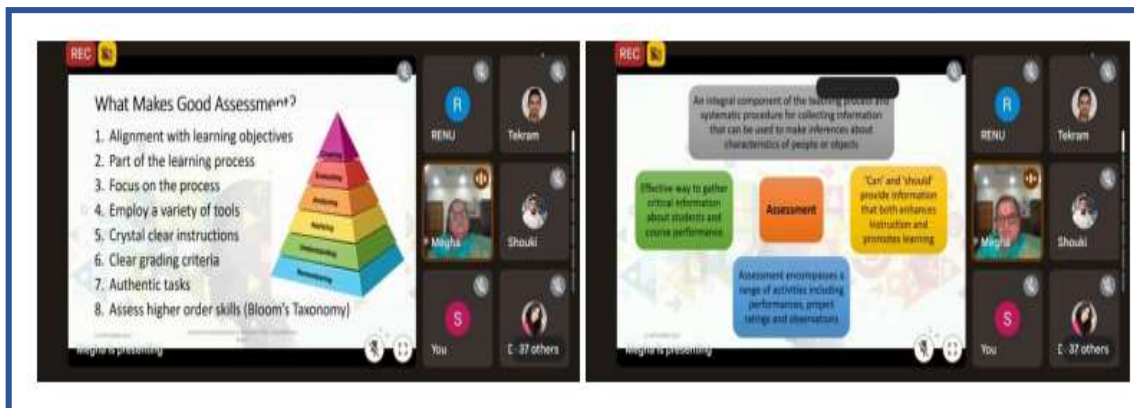

### **Module 03: Teaching Learning and Assessment**

The lecture covered topics like the distinction between assessment and evaluation, the role of assessment in education, and the need for assessment, including its role in providing feedback and student profiling. It also discussed e-assessment as a faster feedback method, various types of evaluation (formative, summative, formal, and informal), and the significance of assessment in the teaching-learning process. The lecture emphasized the importance of different types of tests, PARAKH's role in assessment and evaluation, and the overall purpose of assessment.

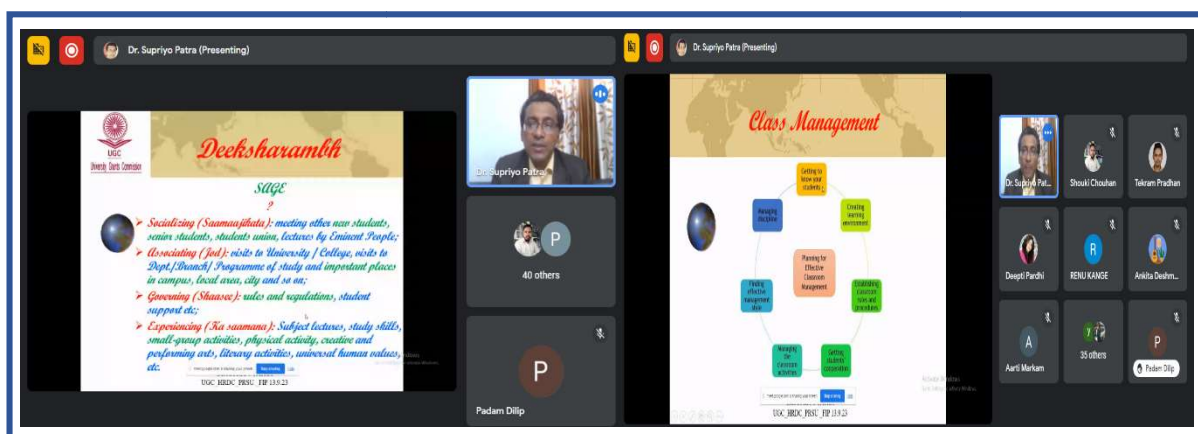

Day 7<sup>th</sup> 13/09/2023: First Session to Fourth Session 10:30 PM to 05:30 PM

On the 7<sup>th</sup> day of this program, **Mr. Yugbodh Patle**, Assistant Professor of Physics, was the chairperson, and **Mr. Padam Dilip**, Assistant Professor of Biochemistry, was the rapporteur. 40 members participated in this session.

In the first two sessions, Dr. Supriyo Patra, ex-professor-in-charge of Management at St. Xavier's College, Kolkata, discussed "Teaching as a Profession." He emphasized the significance of dreams, life's memorable moments, the path to success, and essential skills for educators. Dr. Patra quoted Dr. A.P.J. Abdul Kalam's famous quote "Dreams is not what you see in sleep, is the thing which doesn't let you sleep". The participants also shared their thoughts on dreams. In the second lecture, he covered "Effective Class Management and Mentoring Strategies in the New Normal" addressing Deeksharambh, S.A.G.E, student LAMPPS, class management, and mentor-mentee relationships, resulting in an interactive and informative session.

In his first lecture, he discussed "Current Trends in Curriculum Development," focusing on curriculum components, learning objectives, planning cycles, learning outcomes, Bloom's taxonomy, curriculum development models, and

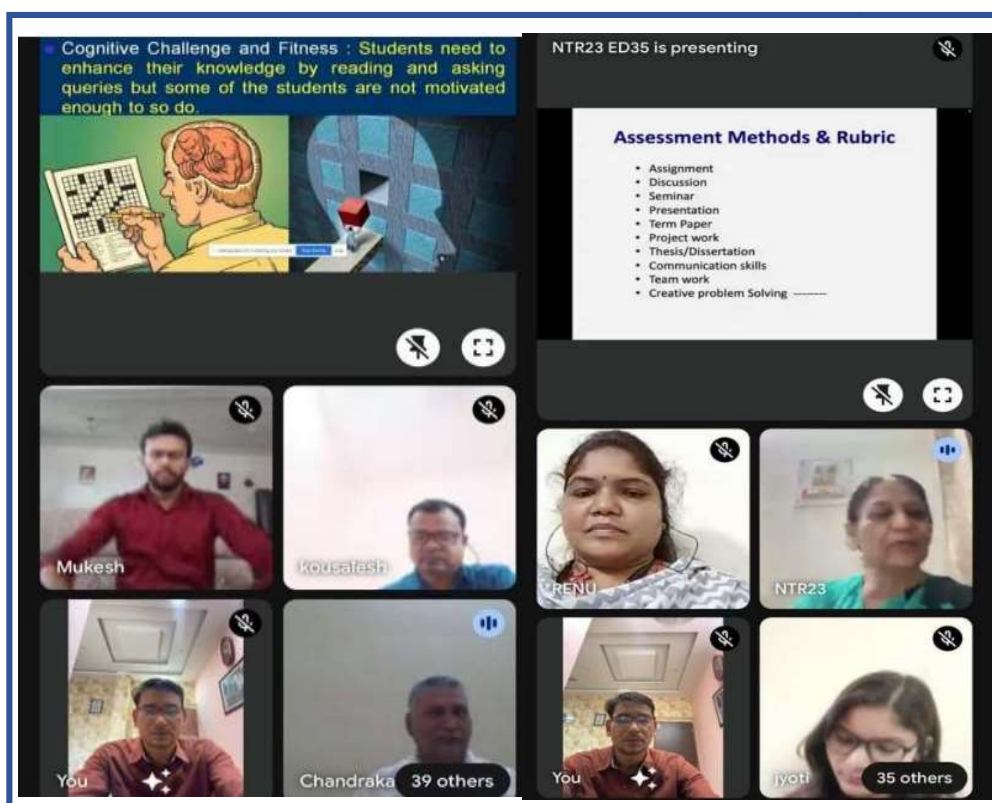

During 2<sup>nd</sup> session (Lecture 33), Prof. C.B. Sharma from IGNOU's School of Education discussed "Redefining Teaching after NEP 2020." He engaged in a Q&A with participants, describing the vision of the National Education Policy (NEP) and its significance. Prof. Sharma also touched on the impact of historical education systems and emphasized education for all, higher education, and the goal of rejuvenating India (Bharat) through education reform.

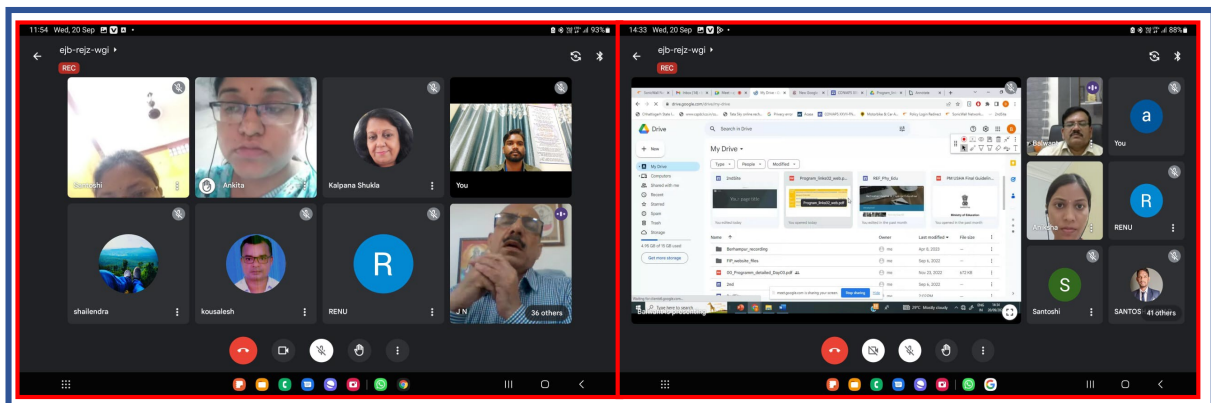

The sessions were informative, and impressive, and inspired participants while enhancing their knowledge and skills.

**Day 10<sup>th</sup> 20/09/2023: First Session to Fourth Session 10:30 PM to 05:30 PM**

On the 10th day of this program, Aniksha Anchal, Assistant Professor of Commerce, was the chairperson, and Mr. Anuranjan Kujur, Assistant Professor of Physics, acted as the reporter. The 40 members participated in this session.

Prof. J.N. Baliya from Central University of Jammu was the Resource Person for two sessions. In the first session, he discussed "ICT Mediated Pedagogy in HEIs: Prefects and Challenges," addressing online teaching and its impact on education. He highlighted changes in social, cultural, physical, and environmental aspects in India.

In the second session, Prof. Baliya covered "Designing and Developing E-Content," focusing on the four Ds: designing, development, distribution, and dissemination for teacher preparation. He discussed E-content's purpose, design, development, the T-PACK framework, open education resources (OER), and various forms of E-content.



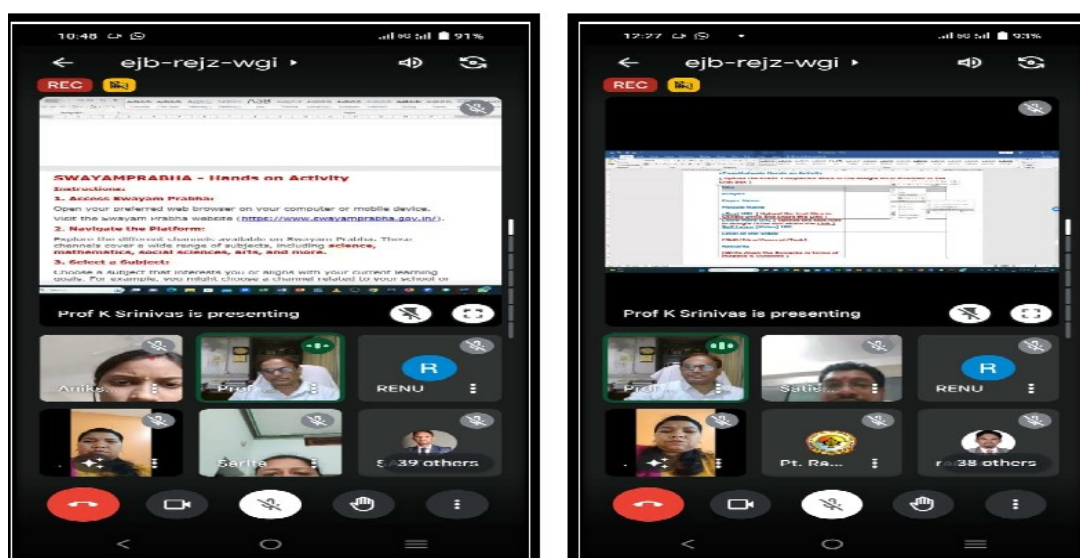

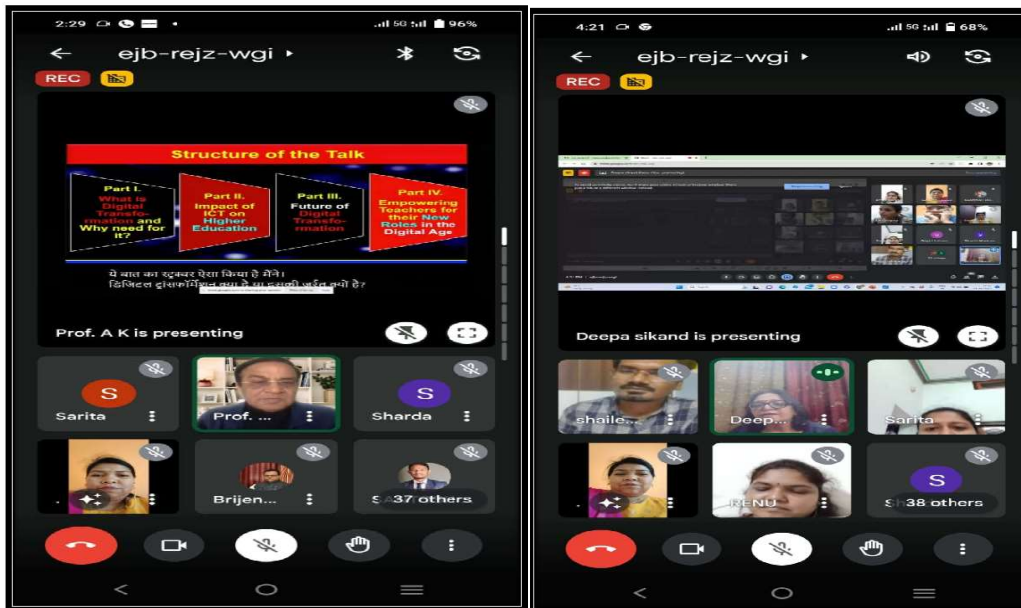

### **Module 05: Personal Emotional Development and Counselling**

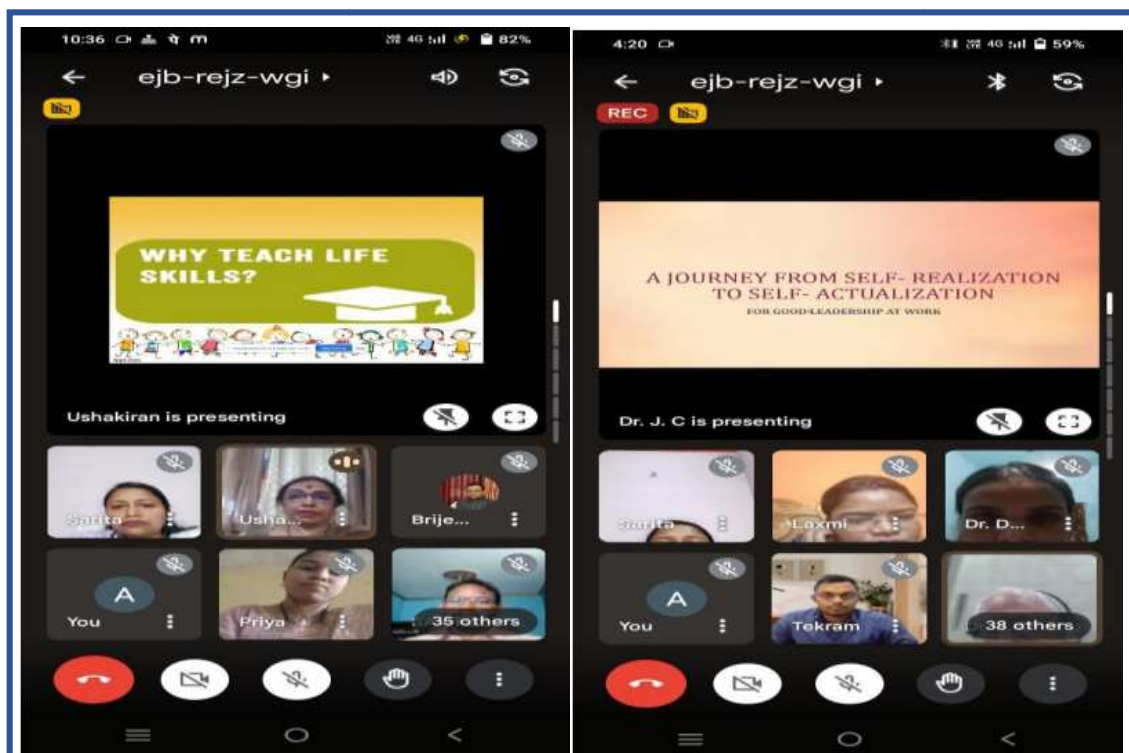

Prof. Kauts also discussed approaches to emotional skill development and the positive outcomes of emotional well-being, including mental awareness, a positive mindset, quality sleep, and effective communication in both personal and professional life.

In the 1st and 2nd sessions, Dr. Usha Kiran Agrawal from Govt. D.B. PG College, Raipur, served as the Resource Person. She discussed "Life Skill Education," defining life skills and emphasizing their importance. Dr. Agrawal elaborated on key life skills recommended by the WHO, including Self Awareness, Empathy, Critical Thinking, Creative Thinking, Decision Making, Problem Solving, Effective Communication, Interpersonal Relationships, Dealing with Stress, and Dealing with Emotions. In the second session, she covered "Mental Health," discussing topics such as Community Interaction, Fundamental Rights, Positive Effects of Mental Health, Salutogenic Approach, Optimism, and Pessimism.

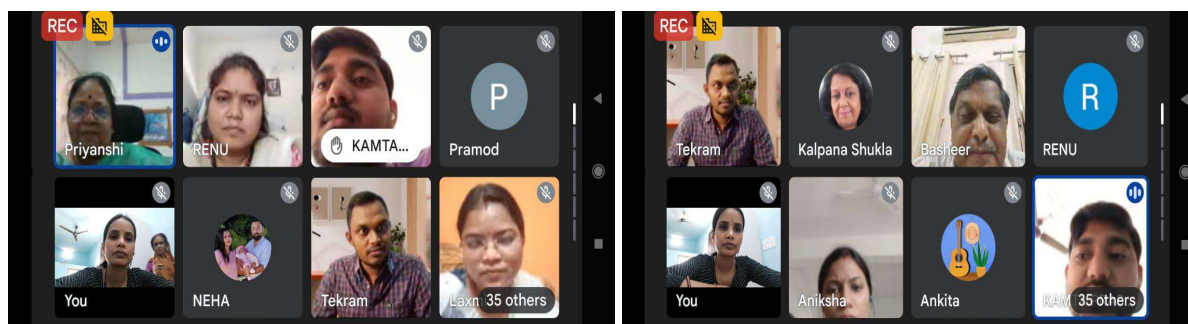

While defining Emotional Intelligence, sir made us aware of its various dimensions which included Interpersonal, Intrapersonal, Adaptation, Stress Management, and Mood Management. Sir also told us in detail about Emotional self-awareness, Assertiveness, Self-regard, self-actualization, and Independence which are dimensions of the Intrapersonal dimension.

**Day 13<sup>th</sup> 25/09/2023: First Session to Fourth Session 10:30 PM to 05:30 PM**

On the 13th day of this program, Mr. Tekram Pradhan, Assistant Professor of Zoology, was the chairperson, and Dr. Deepika, Assistant Professor of Physics, was the reporter. The 40 members participated in this session.

In 1st session, **Prof. Priyamvada Shrivastav**, Professor of Psychology, Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University Raipur, Chhattisgarh, was the Resource Person. She delivered her lecture on “**Stress Management**”. She focused on the effect of stress on the human body, mind, emotions & behavior, the type of stress, its causes, and all possible suggestions to reduce stress. She discussed the General Adaption Syndrome (GAS) Model to explain the stress theory.

In 2nd session, The Resource Person was **Prof. Basheer Hasan**, Professor of Psychology, Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University Raipur, Chhattisgarh. He delivered his lecture on “**Job Related Stress and Its Management**”. The major discussion was on how to utilize our skills, time management, and work capacity to reduce stress as much as possible. Sir emphasized on to develop confidence, a social support system such as family, friends, etc., and regular exercise and meditation for a better and balanced life.



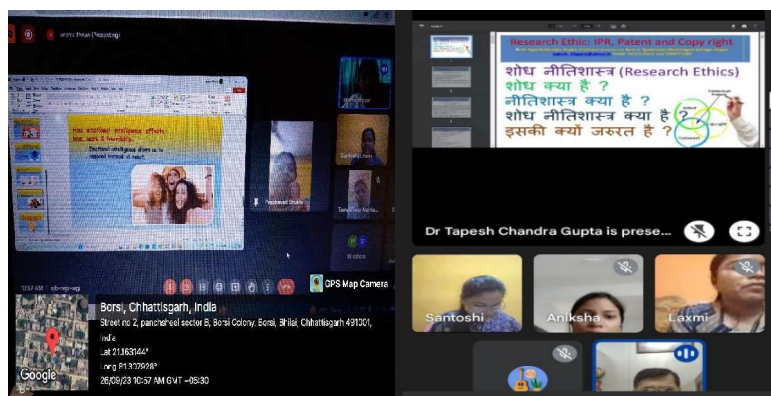

Prof. Rekha Acharya delivered her 1st lecture on “**Consequences of a work-life imbalance among teachers**”. In this lecture, there was a detailed discussion on the side effects of poor work-life balance and all possible strategies and approaches for improving the work-life balance. Her 2nd lecture was on “**Students with learning difficulties**”. The whole lecture was focused on how to identify the learning difficulties in the students, their reasons, and how teachers should work as mentors to remove these difficulties and improve their performance in the learning process.

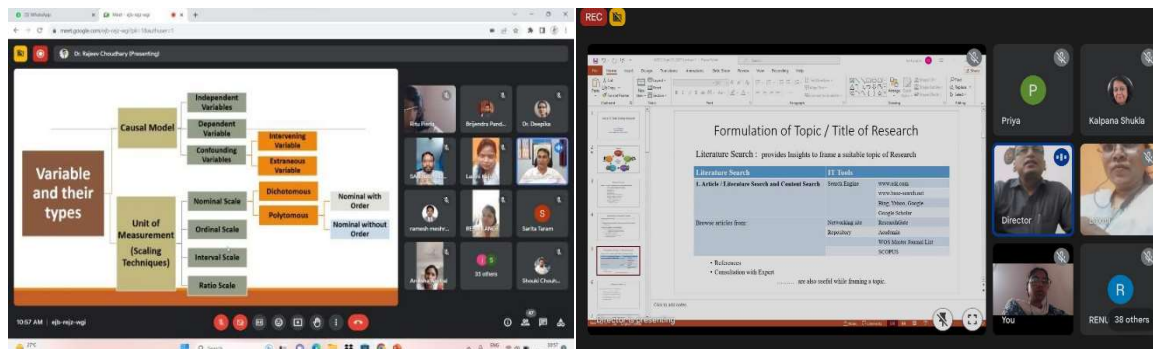

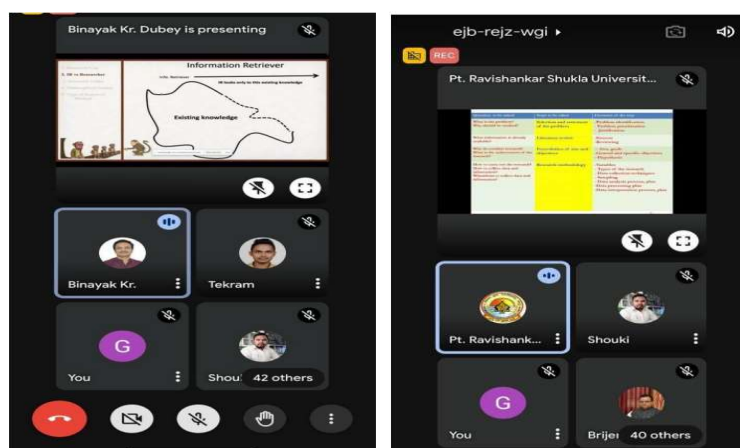

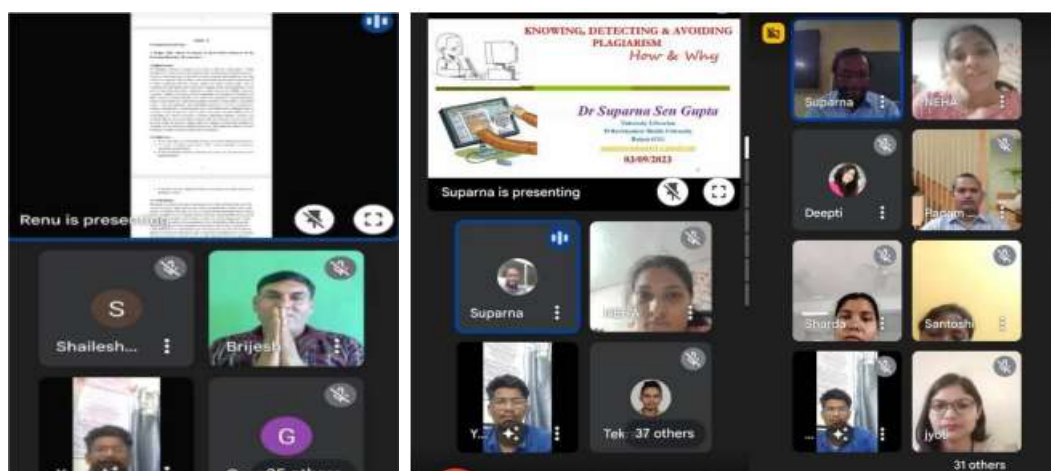

### Module 07: Academic Integrity

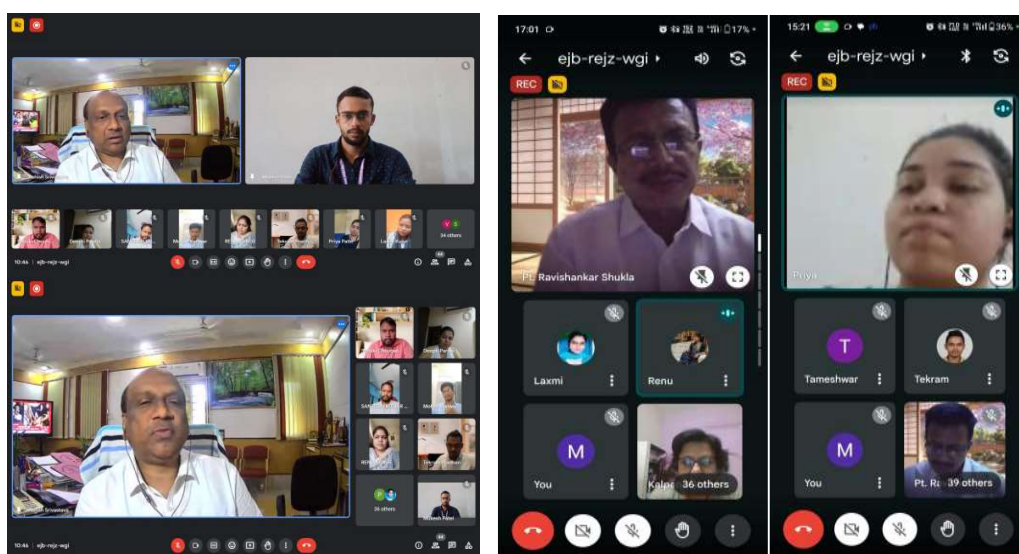

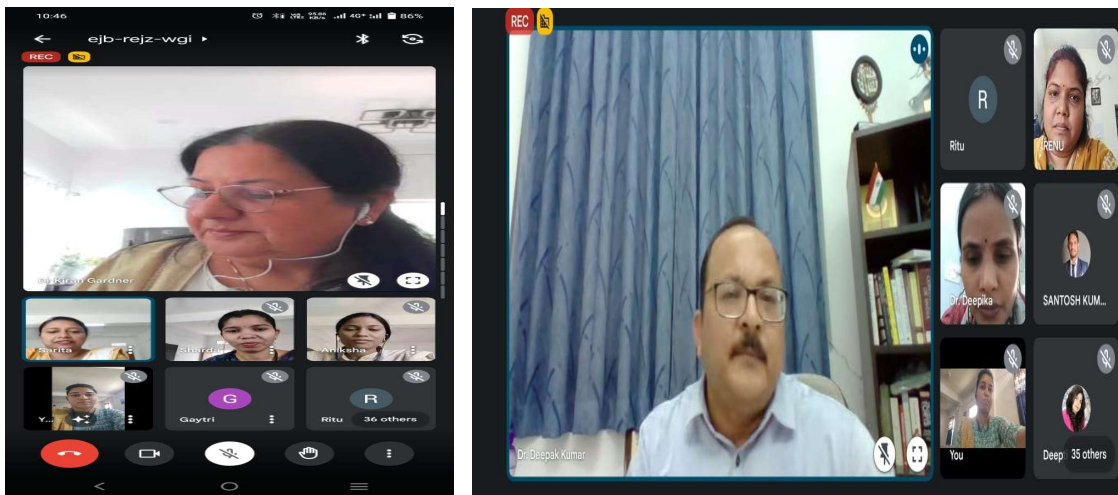
**Day 19<sup>th</sup> 05/10/2023: First Session to Fourth Session 10:30 PM to 05:30 PM**

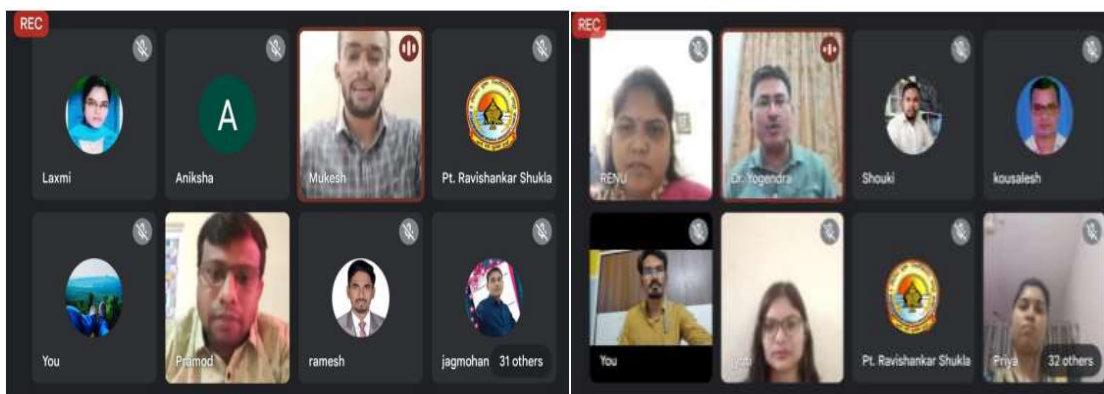

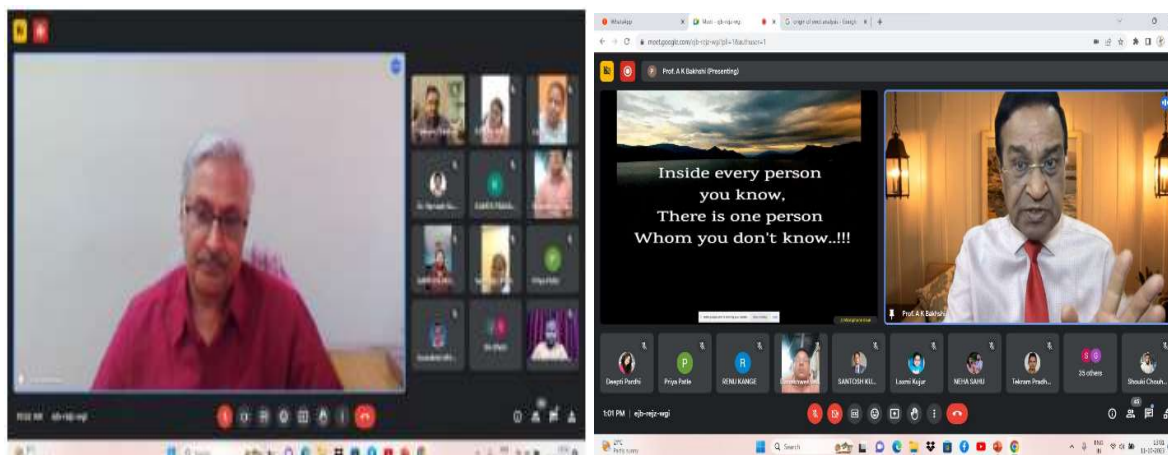

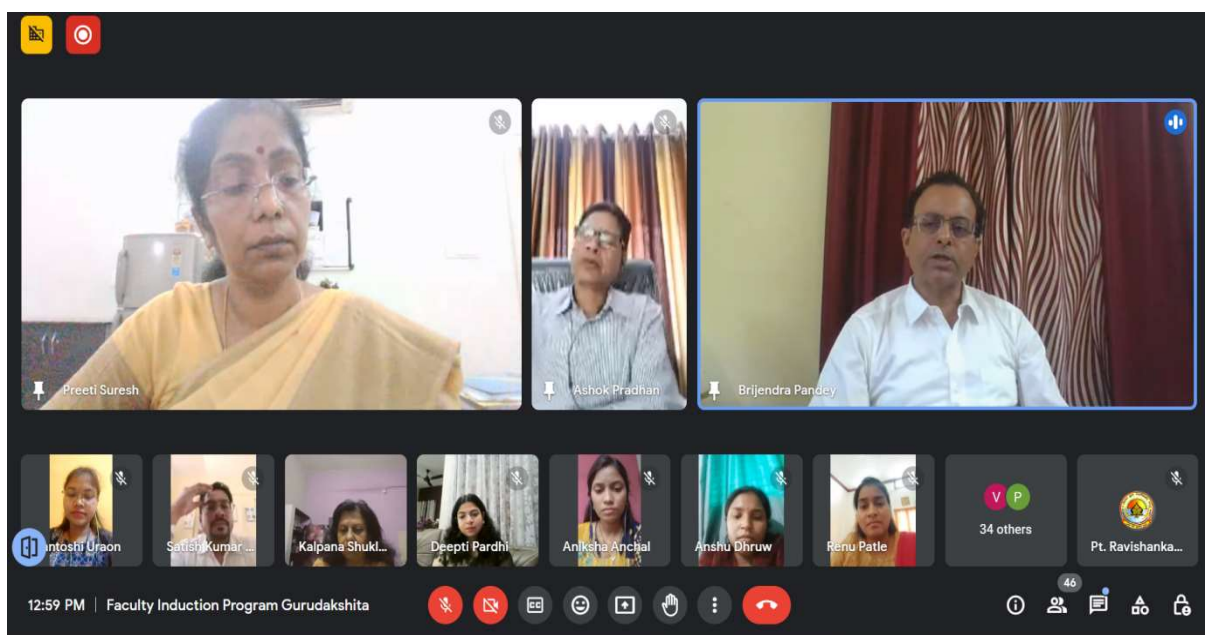

On 12<sup>th</sup> October Valedictory Session of Faculty Induction Program was organized by MMTTC Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University Raipur.

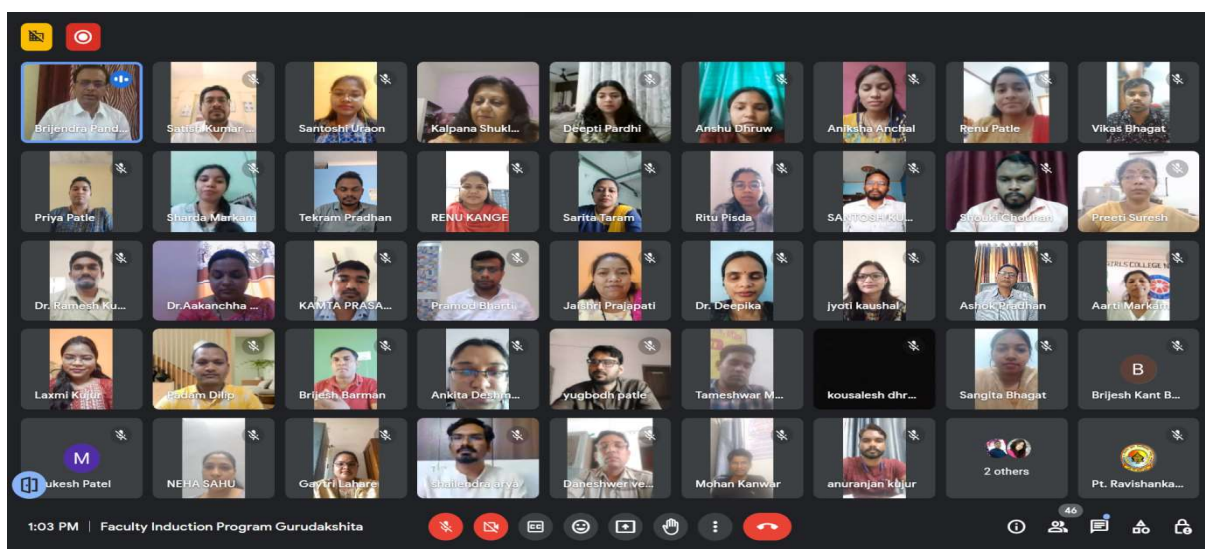
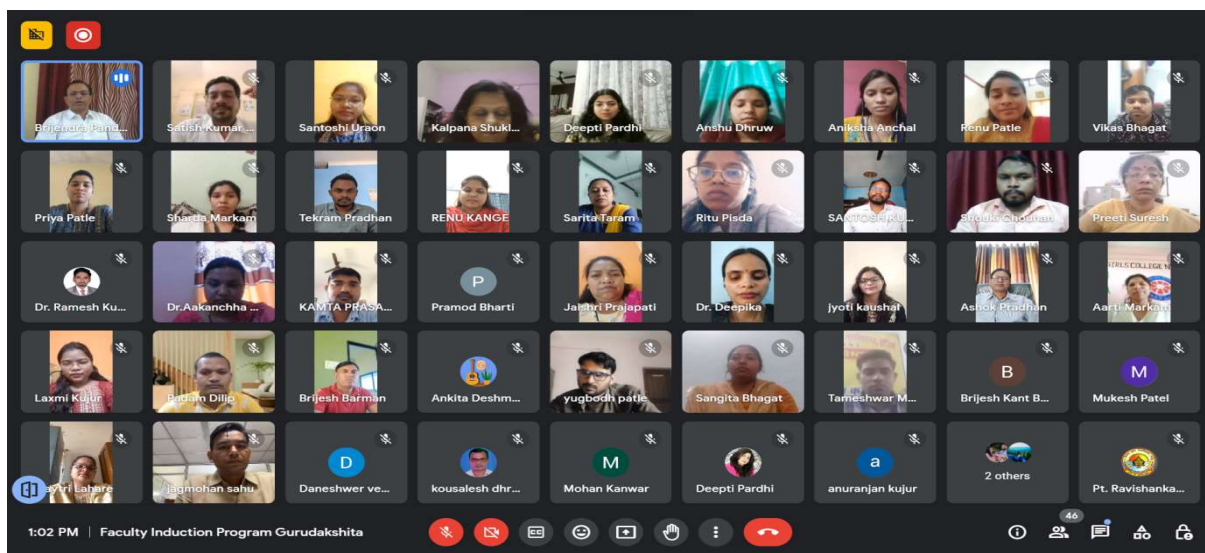
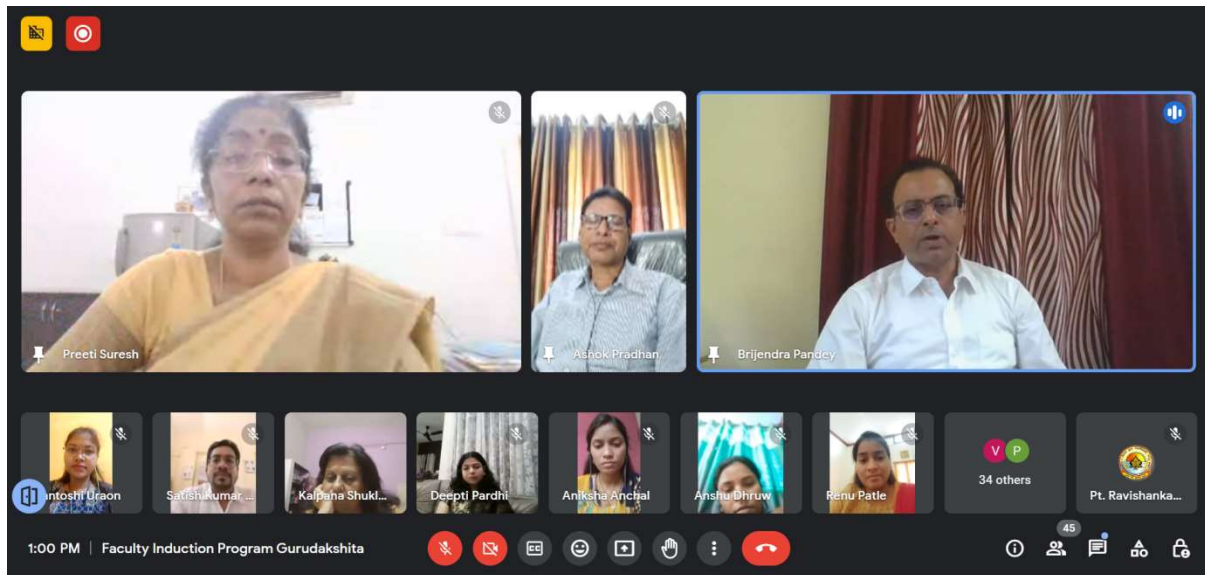
