Detail of date wise organized program

Refresher course in Research Methodology in Social Science was scheduled from 05th to 20th February 2024 on Online mode. The theme of the refresher course was Social Science. In all there were 48 sessions including inaugural and valedictory functions, 6 Sessions were scheduled for micro teaching, project evaluation and seminars, 2 sessions for each respective activity from participants in all 40 lectures were organized on three broad themes of Social Science they were Understanding Social Science at Individual and organizational level.

Day 1
05.02.2024

Session I (10.30-12.00) Inaugural Function

The Inaugural Session for the refresher course was started off by welcoming the attendants by Dr Brijendra Pandey, through online mode at Google meet platform. The event was inaugurated in the gracious presence of Prof. Sachchidanand Shukla Vice Chancellor of Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur (Chhattisgarh). Then an introduction was given by the participants, and the highlights of the refresher course were explained by the course coordinator, Prof. Rajeev Choudhary. Prof. Preeti K. Suresh, Director, MMTTC, addressed the participants and Prof. Sachchidanand Shukla, Vice Chancellor of the university, delivered the inaugural address and spoke about the essentials for excellence in teaching and lecturing and the ingredients required for an effective lecture. He urged the participants to interact with the experts taking part in the refresher course and wished that their experiences with Pt. Session II (12:15 to 13:45)



Dr. G.K. Deshmukh, working as an associate professor at the Institute of Management at Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, gave a lecture on the topic Identification of Fake, Predatory and Cloned Journals. He started his lecture by saying that every year, 5,000 researchers in the country become victims of cloned journals, and it makes tremendous business, which businesses usually earn significant profit from journal papers. UGC would initiate the publishing of papers. UGC says publishing papers in de-recognized journals will affect promotion & appointments. Then he explained the authenticity of the journal: Predatory Journals- these journals are scam publishers that charge an author's fee, often without performing quality checks for issues such as plagiarism or ethical approval. The majority of these journals take payments without ever publishing the work, while others publish articles without any form of editorial or peer review process. They also talked about indicators of predatory journals. He also told us about cloned journals that Hijacked journals are making duplicate or fake websites of legitimate ones utilizing the title, ISSN and other information of the reputable journal to try and attract authors. He also gave examples of many cloned journals on the UGC care list and explained many possible solutions with

the help of which we can avoid cloned journals. He gave detailed information about the University Grants Commission Consortium for Academic and Research Ethics (UGC-CARE) and how the UGC CARE Journal list plays a vital role in the scholarly publishing landscape. It serves as a comprehensive and up-to-date resource for researchers, academicians, and publishers to identify quality academic journals across various disciplines. The list serves as a reliable indicator of a journal's credibility, quality, and impact within the academic community. During the discussion, he satisfied the participants by clearing all queries. The presentation technique were very effective with PPT and effective communication, eye contact and interaction with the participants made the lecture very interesting and innovative. Comments: The lecture was very informative. Such a type of lecture must be part of our refresher course to harness the best results.

इसके लिए aegaeum जर्नल, Adalya Journal, Scopus, Sage journal, Inspa journal, Domointools, IP Adress, IP Location आदि के बारे में विस्तार से जानकारी दी गई। साथ ही रिसर्च पेपर कैसे लिखना चाहिए, एक रिसर्च पेपर ने कौन कौन से प्वाइंट शामिल करना चाहिए के बारे में भी जानकारी प्राप्त हुआ।
