Dr. (Mrs.) Anusuiya Baghel (DoB - 30-03-1957) Professor, School of Studies in Geography, obtained her M.A. (stand 2nd in order of merit) and M. Phil. (with merit) degree in Geography from Ravishankar University, Raipur in 1979 and 1980 respectively and joined the department as Senior Technical Assistant in 1983 and as Lecturer in 1988. She obtained her Ph.D. degree in Geography from Ravishankar University, Raipur in 1986. The title of her Ph.D. Thesis is “POPULATION GEOGRAPHY OF SEONATH BASIN”. Later she was elevated to post of Reader in 1998 and then Professor in 2010. Her fields of specialization and interest are Geography of Population, Geography of Resources, Agricultural Geography and Tribal Studies.

Dr. Baghel has written three books and about 75 research papers in various Indian and International Journals and edited books. She has completed a research project (Sponsored by UGC) “Fertility Patterns among the Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes in Raipur Division” in 2001. Co-investigator in the Project (Sponsored by UGC, New Delhi) “Infant Mortality in Rural Chhattisgarh” in 2007. Ten Research Scholars have completed their Ph. D. work under the supervision of Dr. Baghel. She is life member of a number of learned Societies and member of Editorial Board of Deccan Geographical Society, the Journal of Bengal Geographers and Journal of Ravishankar University. She is member of Executive Committee, NAGI, for period 2005-06. She is former Head School of Studies in Geography, Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University, Raipur and also former Chairperson Board of Studies of the same. She has given lectures on different topics and resource person for various other programmes. She has attended more than 75 National Seminar/Conferences/Workshops and International conferences. She is also on the advisory board of various national committees. At Present she is the Assistant Warden of Girls’ Hostel and Assistant Proctor of the University. Major Achievements are Awarded Gold Medal for Presentation of the Best Paper in UGC Sponsored National Seminar, 2000 and Geography Teacher Award, 2009 during 9th Deccan Geography Conference, 2010.
