During pregnancy, a woman's body undergoes major changes to support the growth of her unborn child. Pregnancy-related hormonal changes have a significant impact on a woman's perception of taste, smell, and sight. There are also notable changes to the kidneys and heart, an increase in body fat, and physiological adjustments to the uterus and breasts. Pregnancy causes specific and noticeable alterations in the human brain's neural architecture and network structure, especially to the Default Mode Network. These changes may be the reason behind changes in the neural representation of the self throughout motherhood. The placenta and the mother's glands both release hormones that are responsible for these alterations. Maternal health has a significant impact on fetal health. The goal of this project is to investigate how pregnant women's speech patterns relate to changes in their hormone levels, ECG, EEG in order to monitor their behaviour and physical health and so as the fetal health too .Up until now, diagnosing patients with hormone imbalances has always needed a pathological laboratory and experience. But in remote areas, medical and pathology assistance is not always available around-the-clock. The suggested study creates a unique method for speech signal analysis-based hormone level detection that can be used to track a pregnant woman's physical and behavioral health on her alone or with a companion. This approach of hormone level detection is very simple, pleasant, less expensive, self-evaluable, and does not call for any experience in pathology.

The purpose of this research study is to monitor the health of the mother and the fetus by examining the relationship between speech signal features and hormonal changesthat occur during pregnancy. Also to monitor the behavioural changes due to hormone level shifts through speech signal analysis during the period of pregnancy. Hormone level, ECG, EEG detection involves the pathological laboratory set up and expertise and, the process is time consuming also. The hormonal testing is done usually through either through blood / Urine / saliva sample. Sample collection and its further processing is quite complex if has to be done on regular basis during period of pregnancy for a woman. The proposed study identifies a non invasive technique using speech signal analysis for hormonal level shift detection, heart condition monitoring and behavioral monitoring of expectant mother which helps to ensure the fetal wellbeing also. Patient herself will be able to record her voice to monitor her hormonal level, Heart parameters instantly. This technique requires only a microphone recorder and computer or laptop set with the required software installed in it, no other special laboratory set up is required. If any unusual changes are observed, the patient can visit her doctor and get proper medical care

**Hypothesis/ Research question (up to 100 words) :** This work focuses on the specific hormone changes detection that occur during the pregnancy using speech signal analysis for behavoiral and physiological health monitoring of expectant mother. The patient has to utter and record the speech signal. It is possible to extract speech components like Formant Frequency F1, F2, and Fundamental Frequency F0 using a linear predictive coding approach, with the help of sophisticated signal processing techniques and tools. Since Formant Frequency reflects the complex anatomical and psychological aspects of the human body it is used to assess the physiological features of human body.

# Methodology

**Study Design :** This research study is aimed to record the speech, ECG, EEG and Pathological hormonal level data of 50 – 60 expectant mothers of age group 21 to 40 years during their pregnancy period for and no-pregnancy period that is in normal medical condition. The data collection of the same patient has to be done for every trimester during her gestational period. The framework of the proposed research is described by the flow chart in Figure 1.1.

**Study Area :** The research data is to be collected from AIIMS, Government Private Hospitals and clinics situated at different locations in Chhattisgarh State in India. Speech Data would be recorded in digital form by using speaker microphone and research study purpose laptops. EEG of the patients is collected by using 32 Channel wearable EEG Cap System Saline with Laptop. Pathological Hormonal data is also collected at the same time from same patient. Pathological data also sent for further processing at the research study centre. This collected data would be then sent to a high end server for further data processing at the research study centre.

**Sample Size :** The subject volume for the proposed study is 50-60 women. The speech EEG,ECGand Hormonal level detection samples would be collected every fortnightly. The speech sample includes 11 vowels and 35 consonants of Hindi language. One time recording of speech signal create 56 speech utterances. Speech utterances volume size available for all the samples during their gestational period would be (50 women x 19.554 fortnights x 56 utterances) 54,751 for processing and analysis.
