Eligibility Criteria

- ◆ Anyone enrolled in a program at University Teaching Departments of PRSU can participate.
- ◆ The team can consist of 1-4 members.
- ◆ The team members need not belong to the same department/subject.
- ◆ No participant can be a part of more than one team.
- ◆ No participant is allowed to switch teams mid-contest.

Themes

Participating team has to propose solution to problems related to one of the following themes :

- ◆ Renewable Energy Technology
- ◆ Water Resource Technology & Management
- ◆ Solid Waste Management
- ◆ Wasteland Management
- ◆ Agriculture Technology & Management
- ◆ Health Care & Elderly Care
- ◆ Automation, Innovation & Supply Chain Management
- ◆ Environmental Technology & Sustainability
- ◆ Out of the box (other than the above topics)



Support

Selected Ideas (maximum up to five) will be supported to propel them forward.

Rules and Regulations

- ◆ Please ensure Participants should fill out the registration form on time. Incorrect or missing information can invalidate eligibility.
- ◆ All required information must be provided for your submission to be eligible as mentioned on the registration form.
- ◆ The entry limit is 1-4 members in one team overall. Any attempt by anyone to obtain more than the stated number of submissions by using multiple/different accounts, identities, registrations, logins, or any other methods will void your submissions and you may be disqualified. Use of any automated system to participate is prohibited.
- ◆ The competition will be in 2 rounds, Preliminary (Round-I: Elimination Round) and (Round -II: Final Pitching)
- ◆ Round-I: This will be an online round where all the registered teams have to submit their Problem and Solution with the requisite details in slides.
- ◆ Round-II: It will be an offline where qualifying teams will present their problem and solution to the jury on-campus.
- ◆ The decision of the Jury will be final and there will not be a review or an appeal against decision, nor will there be a request for re-evaluation.
