- No participant is allowed to switch teams mid-contest.

- Solid Waste Management
- Wasteland Management
- Agriculture Technology & Management
- Health Care & Elderly Care
- Automation, Innovation & Supply Chain Management
- Environmental Technology & Sustainability
- Out of the box (other than the above topics )



Selected Ideas (maximum up to five) will be supported to propel them forward.

# **Rules and Regulations**

- Please ensure Participants should fill out the registration form on time. Incorrect or missing information can invalidate eligibility.
- All required information must be provided for your submission to be eligible as mentioned on the registration form.
- The entry limit is 1-4 members in one team overall. Any attempt by anyone to obtain more than the stated number of submissions by using multiple/ different accounts, identities, registrations, logins, or any other methods will void your submissions and you may be disqualified. Use of any automated system to participate is prohibited.
- The competition will be in 2 rounds, Preliminary (Round-I: Elimination Round) and (Round -II: Final Pitching)
- Round-I: This will be an online round where all the registered teams have to submit their Problem and Solution with the requisite details in slides.
- Round-II: It will be an offline where qualifying teams will present their problem and solution to the jury oncampus.
- The decision of the Jury will be final and there will not be a review or an appeal against decision, nor will there be a request for re-evaluation.
