ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY:

Pt. Ravishankar Shukla University (PRSU), Raipur is the biggest and oldest University of the state of Chhattisgarh. It was established on May 01,1964. It is named after Pt. Ravishankar Shukla, the first Chief Minister of Madhya Pradesh. The University started functioning from June 1,1964 with 46 affiliated colleges. Later Mrs. Indira Gandhi, the then Minister of Information & Broadcasting, Govt. of India inaugurated the university teaching department (UTD) with five Post Graduate departments on July 2, 1965. The University campus is enriched with greenery and peace. Pollution free natural environment is conducive for higher learning.

Chhattisgarh was carved out of Madhya Pradesh on 1st November, 2000 as new political entity. PRSU, being the oldest University, is leaving no stone unturned to cater to the needs of the society. There are 29 teaching departments in the campus including Philosophy & Yoga.

ABOUT THE SOS:

SWAMI VIVEKANANDA MEMORIAL SCHOOL OF STUDIES IN COMPARATIVE RELIGION, PHILOSOPHY & YOGA was established in 1985 with M.A.& Ph.D. degrees in Philosophy and M.Phil in Comparative Religion & Philosophy. Initially the name of the Department was Comparative Religion and Philosophy. Four faculty members Dr. R.P.Pandey, Dr. L.P. Mishra, Dr. Bhagwant Singh and Dr. B.K.Rao were appointed initially to start the Department. In the year 2002, P.G.Diploma & Certificate Courses in Yoga Education & Philosophy started by the UGC through a project initiated by Dr. Bhagwant Singh. In the session 2006-07 the SoS started M.A. in Applied Philosophy & Yoga. Later the SoS is renamed as Swami Vivekananda Memorial School of Studies in Comparative Religion, Philosophy & Yoga. At present 163 students are enrolled in the SoS. 28 students qualified NET examination including 03 JRF within 04 years after YOGA identified as a separate discipline by U.G.C. for NET examination.

To prepare the young generation for participating in building of a peaceful World-Society based upon the cherished values of Democracy, Equality, Social-justice, Plurality and Human dignity.
