

ORDINANCE NO. 95

P.G. DIPLOMA IN WATER RESOURCES MANAGEMENT

- 1/ The examination for PG Diploma in WRM shall be yearly.
- 2/ A candidate who after obtaining Masters Degree of Science (in Geology, Forestry, Agriculture Sciences) of the University or an examination of any Statutory University in India, which has been recognised by the University as equivalent to M.Sc. Degree of the University shall be admitted to the Examination for the P.G. Diploma in Water Resources Management.

OR

- A candidate who after obtaining BE (Civil Engineering) of the University or equivalent Examination of any Statutory University in India as equivalent to BE (Civil), will be admitted to the examination for the P.G. Diploma in WRM.
- 3/ The examination shall be partly by means of 5 papers and partly by 2 practicals and one Field Work / Dissertation.
- 4/ A candidate will be declared successful if he/she obtains at least 36% of the aggregate marks in the subject. A candidate is required to pass in the Theory Papers and Practical's separately by obtaining not less than 36% marks.
Successful candidates who obtain 60% marks or more of the aggregate marks shall be placed in the First Division, those obtaining less than 60% but not less ^{then} 48% in the Second Division, and those obtaining less than 48% in the Third Division.
- 5/ A candidate who does not succeed in the examination may be allowed to reappear as non-collegiate student.
